Job Analysis Survey

Executed the five-year Job Analysis Survey. Developed and published Job Analysis Report that will be an integral part of the exam baseline.

Updated ISP® History In Work

After several years of being placed on hold, the ISP[®] History update was initiated and will be released during 59th BoD year.





- Maintained 361 active ISP[®]s.
- Obtained 2021-2022 program ANAB Accreditation.
- Completed Confidentiality and Conflict of Interest (CCOIs) for the 58th board year (ISP[®] Committee and all beta testers).
- Completed the annual program review and presented to President Lynn Burns, ISP[®].
- \succ Completed a 100% review of all test questions for content validity.
- > Conducted a beta test of questions revised for content changes due to policy changes and statistical problems (i.e., too easy, too difficult, not correlating to overall performance).
- > Maintained the restricted roster of volunteers subject to the two-year restriction. between the EPP, beta testers, and ISP[®] Exam Questions Subcommittee participation.
- Completed the 2021 exam candidate survey and analyzed responses for program effectiveness and enhancements.
- \succ Continued to use the ISP[®] Certification Community for on-line collaboration, resources, and announcing newly awarded certification recipients.

- Implemented ISP[®] Lifetime Designation. Note: the designation was discontinued by 58th BoD.





> Developed the ISP[®] Exam Question Acronym listing to ensure candidates are aware of the acronyms used in the exam which will no longer be spelled

> Developed the ISP[®] Exam Test Sources and Study References online listing for the new Sep 2022 exam and updated the listing for the current exam. > Produced requisite documentation for beta testing events, Exam Prometric Update Master, Job Analyses reports, and the Prometric Analysis Report.






CEU SUBCOMMITTEE ÁCCOMPLISHMENTS
